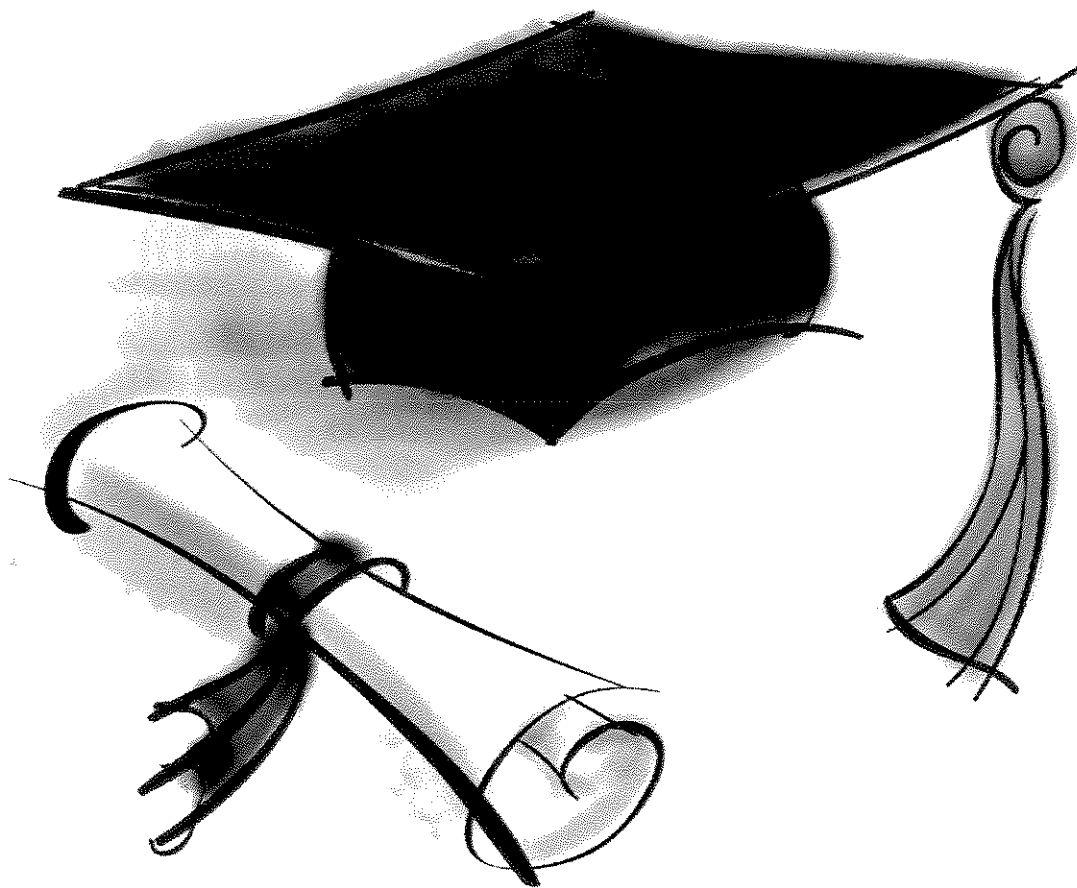

Undergraduate Scholarship Application

Background

The West Central Ohio Safety Council is a not for profit organization that was established to provide a forum for education and sharing of information on Health and Safety related topics. The Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation and membership dues fund the council. The Safety Councils activities include monthly meetings and an Annual Awards Banquet. The goals of the safety council include:

- Provide a forum for the exchange of ideas and experiences on safety issues.
- To provide information and assistance to the members of the Council whether through education or sharing of ideas.
- Promote safe positive work environments to area employers.

The Scholarship

There will be two scholarships in the amount of \$500.00 each awarded for the 2012/2013 academic year. Successful recipients must be U.S. Citizens and enrolled full-time at the senior level (during the 2011/2012 school year) and must demonstrate an interest in pursuing a career in the field of Occupational Safety and Health, Industrial Hygiene, Environmental Science, Risk Management or a related field. Senior level high school students planning on graduating in May/June of 2012 will be eligible for the scholarship. The completed scholarship application must be received by Monday, March 12, 2012 by 4:00 pm. The scholarship will be awarded at our Annual Awards Banquet held on April 10, 2012 at the Knights of Columbus. Recipients will be asked to accept the award and say a few words.

Minimum Criteria:

Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or above and recommendation by their academic advisor. They must also complete the application of short answer questions.

Basis for Award: *The applicant will be based on the following:*

- Content of short answer application
- Academic Excellence
- Work Experience/Activities
- Future Ambitions regarding Safety Program

- Copy of High School Transcripts
- Letter from Academic Counselor/Advisor
- Completed Application
