Morning Session (10 lessons)

Afternoon Session (10 lessons)

Classes Times: 12:30 pm – 2:00 pm each Saturday.

•**Fee: \$89** *(includes all supplies for weekly instruction for 10 classes.)*

*Families may sign up for both sessions. The child will receive two different art experiences and have a different morning and afternoon instructor. **The fee for both sessions and, therefore, 20 art lessons would be \$178.00.***

Students interested in these classes will need to be pre-registered. *Registration must be completed **online**.
