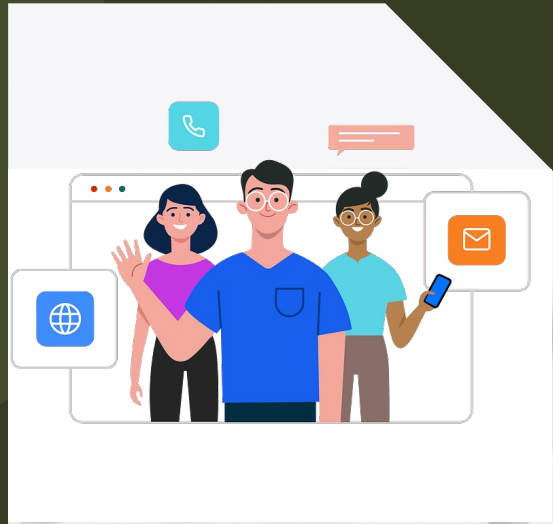
Many schools have scholarships beyond the typical incoming First year scholarships
