- Individuals with disabilities sign up for the species they would like to show (Chicken, Rabbit, Goat, Sheep)
- · Junior Fair members with animal projects will sign up to be mentors
- Mentors (Junior Fair members) and Individuals with disabilities (Mentees) will be paired before the show
 - They will meet the animal and discuss the project
- · Together they will show the animal
- · Judges will visit each project and ask the participants about the animal
