AWLS Instructional Framework

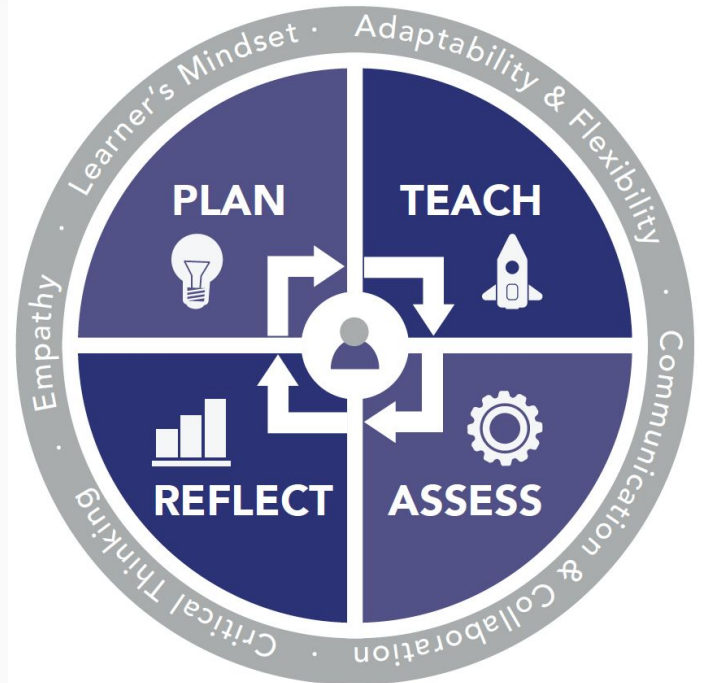
- Developed with input from all staff
