Kindergarten

Last week, I visited the Kindergarten classrooms to discuss the differences between big problems and small problems. The students learned that a

"small" problem involves a minor situation that can normally be solved on your own or with the help of a friend or classmate. Usually, it is not necessary to involve the assistance of an adult when solving a small problem. Some examples of small problems include another student making silly noises when you are working or trouble locating a pencil or another supply. "Big" problems are situations that need the immediate attention of an adult and should be reported to the respective teacher or supervisor upon discovery. Some examples of big problems are a student getting hurt or a potentially dangerous situation. This has helped the students to understand the differences between "tattling" and "telling."




