Starting School at AWLS

- For students in grades K-4: Call the school office to learn your child's teacher assignment and transportation arrangements and confirm their start date.
- For students in grades 5-12: Schedule an appointment with your child's school counselor to discuss their course selection and schedule and confirm their start date.

Making Transportation Arrangements

- Visit www.AnthonyWayneSchools.org/Transportation, click on Transportation Links for Families, and complete the form applicable to your situation. Also review the General Transportation Information link for bus rules, policies and procedures for using school transportation.
- Once assigned, your child's bus information will be shared with the school office, sent home with your child, added to your PowerSchool account and mailed to your home address. New students are routed as quickly as possible, but it can take up to three days. Delays may be longer within the first two weeks of a new school year.

Accessing PowerSchool

- You will receive a letter from your child's school that includes a unique AccessID and instructions for creating a PowerSchool Parent Account. This will enable you to view your child's grades and attendance throughout the year. This letter also contains your child's 6-digit school ID.

Eating Meals at School

- Breakfast and lunch menus, Free and Reduced Meal eligibility requirements and applications, and instructions for sending money to school are available at www.AnthonyWayneSchools.org/FoodServices.
- We encourage setting up a PaySchoolsCentral.com account for paying for school meals and other fees securely online. You will need your child's 6-digit school ID code to set up your account.

Communicating with Anthony Wayne Local Schools

- Please keep your contact information up to date in your child's school office. Your cell phone number and email address are critical to ensuring you receive important information and are reachable in the event of illness or emergency.
- Anthony Wayne Local Schools primarily uses email to send newsletters, school/district information and other updates to families. Please check your email frequently for these messages.
- In the event of school delay, closing or emergency, you will receive a phone call, email and text message from Instant Connect, our automated communications system. Please note that Federal law requires parent to opt-in to receive text messages. You may do so by texting YES to 875-69.
