IDENTIFY CONCERNS



Our main concern within our community is that we need to expand our school garden. Our concerns within the project is that it is being filmed during winter, so there are no vegetables able to be used from the outdoor garden. Another concern we have is that tower gardens or outdoor gardens are an expense some school may not be able to afford.
